

Photography at Bluff Lake Nature Center



At this time there are no permits necessary for recreational, professional, or commercial photography or videography.

Please note: **Drone operation is prohibited** at Bluff Lake. They stress out the wildlife, especially birds.

While visiting, please stay safe, and help us keep Bluff Lake wild and natural by following our wildlife-friendly rules:

- Stay on trails. Walking or standing off trail can disrupt wildlife, damage vegetation, and cause erosion.
- No music or loud noises. Loud noises will scare wildlife and disturb other visitors.
- No dogs. Even leashed dogs stress wildlife; please bring pets elsewhere.
- No glitter or sparklers. Dispose of waste in trash cans located around the site.
- Trails are for walking and jogging. Please, no horses, bikes or motorized vehicles.
- Park bikes on top of the bluff in the parking lot.
- The lake is not suitable for wading, swimming, or boating.
- No food or drink beyond the parking lot.
- No alcohol or drugs.
- No firearms, paintball, or archery.
- If you have a group of 20 people or more, please call our offices to schedule a time for your visit.

Reminder that the gates open at sunrise and close promptly at sunset.

Bluff Lake is a nature sanctuary that is open to everyone, so there is no guarantee that the area you want to use will be clear of others. We ask that you please be considerate and thoughtful of other visitors using the site.
